

# THINGS TO CONSIDER FOR YOUR WEDDING:

- How important are amazing couples photos? How much time would you like to carve out for couples photos including getting to those locations? How many hours of daylight will we have on your date?
- Will the bride have a first looks with her Dad and/or soon to be spouse before the ceremony? This is important because it will change your timeline.
- Any rehearsal dinner coverage? Many people want to remember their rehearsal dinner as well as their wedding day since they are so closely linked! Definitely a consideration to make as you plan your wedding.
- How many guests are going to attend? Is it important that everyone you know and their plus one is invited? Or are you cutting as many people from the list as possible? This plays a MASSIVE role in the vibe of your wedding.



## TRADITIONAL WEDDING TIMELINES


Whoever your photographer is, they should make a timeline with you. If they don't, feel free to use this as a guide. Albeit, these are for "traditional" weddings so if you're going for more elopement style, these might not be as helpful.

- 2. Detail Photos.
- 3. First looks.
- 4. Bridal party shots.
- 5. Family/special people formals.
- 6. Ceremony.
- 7. Bride and Groom shots.
- 8. Entrances.
- 9. Welcome speech/prayer/etc.
- 10. Dinner.
- 11. Toasts.
- 12. Cake cutting.
- 13. Bouquet/garter toss, special games, etc.
- 14. Dances.
- 15. Send off!






## QUESTIONS TO ASK YOUR PHOTOGRAPHER BEFORE YOU HIRE THEM.



- Can I see a full wedding gallery? (CHECK SKIN TONES in various lighting conditions. Most good photographers will prioritize skin tones being accurate, this is especially noticeable in the shadows of people's faces.)
- Can you customize a wedding package to fit my wedding specifically?
- How long will it take you to get my photos back to me?
- Do you do prints/album? Are they an additional charge?
- What's your editing style?
- What's your photography philosophy?
- If you are doing a shoot the day before the wedding (whether a private vow session or rehearsal dinner) ask how much they would charge additionally.
- Where can I see your reviews? Can you explain any bad reviews?




